The fish should be on top of the mounds. These fish around there are between20 and 45 pounds. The best way of getting the bad boys is 3 way jigging eels on the out bound tide.:woohoo: Al so i almost forgot on of the nights i hooked up with a striper and it had to be like 50 pounds are bigger snapped my brand new 3 way swivel.i will have some photos up soon of some of the fish the attachment is not working but i willll uplood it so be posted .
